<b>Independent Director:</b>	a director of TASL who is not an employee of TAL Services or a director of another company within the TAL Group.
<b>Internal Director:</b>	a director of TASL who is an employee of TAL Services but who is not an Executive Officer.
<b>LTI:</b>	long-term incentive, see section 6.2 of this report for more information.
<b>Member:</b>	a person who has been admitted as a member of the Fund under its governing rules.
<b>Non-Executive Director:</b>	a director of TASL who is not an employee of TAL Services but who is a director of another company within the TAL Group.
<b>STI:</b>	short-term incentive, see section 6.1 of this report for more information.
<b>Remuneration Recommendation:</b>	has the meaning given in section 4.5 of this report.
<b>TAL Group:</b>	TDA and its subsidiaries, including TAL Life Limited, TAL Services and TASL.
<b>TAL Services:</b>	TAL Services Limited ABN 60 076 105 130.
<b>TASL:</b>	TAL Superannuation Limited ABN 69 003 059 407.

### 4.1 Independent and Non-Executive Directors

### 4.2 Executive Officers

<b>Employed by:</b>	Employed or contracted by TAL Services (as appropriate) and seconded to TASL on a full time basis.
<b>Remuneration components:</b>	Salary, superannuation and STI (as appropriate)
<b>Remuneration set by:</b>	TDA, subject to a Remuneration Recommendation from TASL.
<b>Remuneration received by:</b>	The Executive Officer.
<b>Remuneration paid by:</b>	TAL Services.
<b>Cost recovery:</b>	Facilities Fee.

### 4.3 Internal Directors

<b>Employed by:</b>	TAL Services but seconded to TASL on a part-time basis. The Internal Director is primarily seconded to other companies within the TAL Group.
<b>Remuneration components:</b>	The Internal Director does not personally receive any director fee.
<b>Remuneration set by:</b>	TDA and agreed by TASL.
<b>Remuneration received by:</b>	TAL Services.
<b>Cost recovery:</b>	Facilities Fee.

### 4.4 Secondments and Facilities Fee

TAL Services employs the Internal Director and contracts with the current Executive Officer and seconds them to TASL. In this regard, TASL is part of the TAL Group that includes a service company, TAL Services, which supplies resources to the whole TAL Group (including human resources to TASL so that TASL can administer the Fund, pursuant to a facilities agreement). Under the facilities agreement:

- the human resources supplied by TAL Services are under the direction of TASL;
- TAL Services receives a fee from the Fund in consideration for the resources, including human resources, it provides to TASL ("Facilities Fee"); and

- TAL Services appropriates a portion of the Facilities Fee to cover the cost of providing human resources to TASL (see section 8 for more information).

#### 4.5 Remuneration Recommendations

TASL may make a Remuneration Recommendation to the TAL Group which proposes that the STI of an Executive Officer be adjusted downwards to zero, if appropriate, if TASL believes that the adjustment is necessary to:

- protect the financial position of TASL or the Fund; or
- respond to significant unexpected or unintended consequences.

## 6. INCENTIVE PAYMENTS

### 6.1 STI

The current Executive Officer is not eligible to participate in the TAL Group's STI plan.

### 6.2 LTI

The current Executive Officer is not eligible to participate in the TAL Group's LTI plan.

### 6.3 Director eligibility

Independent Directors and Non-Executive Directors are not eligible to participate in the TAL Group's STI plan or LTI plan.

In his capacity as an employee of TAL Services rather than as a Director, the Internal Director participates in the TAL Group's STI plan and in the TAL Group's LTI plan. The Internal Director's performance expectations are agreed via a series of TAL Group-related goals.

### 6.4 STI payments

STI payment to the Executive Officer (Mr Cleary) for the years ending 31 March 2022 and 2023

Mr Cleary is contracted to TAL Services as a Consultant under a Professional Services Agreement. Mr Cleary is not eligible to participate in the TAL Group's STI plan.

## 7. ADDITIONAL BENEFITS

### 7.1 Non-monetary benefits

No Executive Officer or Director receives non-monetary benefits from TASL or in respect of their service to TASL.

### 7.2 Equity-based remuneration

No Executive Officer or Director receives equity-based remuneration from TASL or in respect of their service to TASL. This includes share-based payments, options, rights over an equity instrument and other equity related payments.
